#### FIRE RISK ASSESSMENT

Replacing fire certification under the Fire Precautions Act 1971, which was the responsibility of the Fire Service, the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005. Applicable to nearly all non-domestic premises, it places a general duty on those controlling premises to ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable :

- The safety of employees,
- In relation to non-employees to take such fire precautions as may reasonably be required in the circumstances to ensure that the premises are safe
- A duty to carry out a fire risk assessment
